## MGM College of Food Technology

MGM College of Food Technology was established during 2008 by the Mahatma Gandhi Mission Trust, Aurangabad. The institute intends to act as a centre of excellence in areas of Food Technology in Maharashtra as the current market demands a rising need for the processing of food. An emphasis on the art of food preservation and increasing the shelf life of traditional food is exercised here. The college is affiliated with (VNMKV) Vasant Naik Marathwada Krishi Vidyapeeth, Parbhani & (M.S.) Maharashtra Council of Agriculture Education and Research, Pune.

This institute initially started at the MGM campus located in N6 CIDCO, Aurangabad but it was later moved to the Gandheli area in 2014, as a condition laid down

by government that food technology to be taught in minimum of 50 acres of land. Gandheli lies on the outskirts of Aurangabad city and retains plenty of land, and the institute has build hostels inside the campus and also provides bus service for all the students. A private mess named 'Shree Gajanan Canteen' facilitates food to the hostellers.

The B. Tech program is designed as a 4-year course with various subjects such as food production, preservation, quality assurance, packaging food, food laws and new product development, and they are taught with the help of qualified faculties and well equipped laboratories. The college also owns a series of mini industries such as fruits and vegetables, dairy processing plant, spices, oil refinery and a bakery unit. This course ensures to give students wider vision in Food Tech by organizing visits for students to additional food

product manufacturing units.

The college has approximately 200 students as of now and has had students with lovely success stories, some students pursuing further PhDs such as Ms. Doke Snehal Dashrat and some turning into entrepreneurs like Mr. Yamgar Shahikant. Internships start in the 7th semester, this is when students are given the important task of making, marketing and selling a product. The profit gained is shared 50-50 between the students & the college. Brands such as Carlsberg, Cadbury, Haldiram's, Parle, Britannia, Nestle etc. are top recruiters for the placement of students.

The college not only focuses on academics, but promotes co-curricular activities and sports. For instance, the students won the university level table tennis competitions and earned a gold medal.
